

PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: May 25th, 2018

1. Introduction and Overview.

This Privacy Policy describes how EXINI Diagnostics AB (publ) (“EXINI,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) collects, uses, and shares information about you and applies to your use of any website that posts a link to this Privacy Policy (collectively, the “Site”). This Privacy Policy does not apply to our information collection activities through the aBSI Software as a Service offering (“Software”), unless otherwise stated below or at the time of collection. Those activities are governed by the Software Agreement between you and EXINI (the “Agreement”).

By using the Site, you consent to our collection, use and disclosure practices, and other activities as described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree and consent, discontinue use of the Site.

2. Information Collection.

A. **Information You Provide.**

We and our Service Providers (defined below) may collect information you provide directly via the Site. For example, we collect information when you register for the Software, contact customer support, or otherwise communicate or transact with us through the Site.

The information we collect may include Personal Information. "**Personal Information**" is information that identifies you personally (whether alone or in combination), such as your first and last name, e-mail address, phone number, affiliation, and profession. You may choose to voluntarily submit certain other information to us through the Site, including Personal Information, but you are solely responsible for your own Personal Information in instances where we have not requested that you submit such information to us.

Personal Information once “**de-identified**” is not subject to this Privacy Policy and we and our Service Providers may treat it as non-Personal Information and use it without obligation to you except as prohibited by applicable law.

B. **Information Collected Automatically.**

We and our Service Providers may automatically collect certain information about you when you access or use the Site (“**Usage Information**”). Usage Information may include IP address, device identifier, browser type, operating system, data regarding network connected hardware, and information about your use of the Site. To the extent that we combine Usage Information with your Personal Information, we will treat the combined information as Personal Information under this Privacy Policy.

The methods that may be used on the Site to collect Usage Information include:

- **Log Information:** Log information is data about your use of the Site, such as IP address, browser type, internet service provider, referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamps, and related data, which is stored in log files.

- **Information Collected by Tracking Technologies:** Cookies, embedded scripts, and other tracking technologies now and hereafter developed (“**Tracking Technologies**”) may be used to collect information about your interactions with the Site or e-mails, including information about your browsing and activity behavior.

- **Cookies**

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user’s device, which may be a session ID cookie or tracking cookie. Session cookies make it easier for you to navigate the Site and expire when you close your browser. Tracking cookies help in understanding how you use the Site, and remain longer. Cookies may remain on your hard drive for an extended period of time. If you use your browser’s method of blocking or removing cookies, some features and functionalities of the Site may not work. The Site may associate some or all of these types of cookies with your devices.

- **Embedded Scripts**

An embedded script is programming code designed to collect information about your interactions with the Site. It is temporarily downloaded onto your device from our web server or a third party with whom we work, is active only while you are connected to the Site, and deleted or deactivated thereafter.

Some information about your use of the Site and certain Third Party Services (defined below) may be collected using Tracking Technologies across time and services and used by EXINI and third parties for purposes such as to associate different devices you use.

For further information on Tracking Technologies and your choices regarding them, please see “Third Party Services and Analytics” and “Your Choices” below.

C. Information from Other Sources.

We may obtain information about you from other sources, including Service Providers and Third Party Services, and combine such information with information we have collected about you. To the extent we combine such third party sourced information with Personal Information we have collected about you on the Site, we will treat the combined information as Personal Information under this Privacy Policy. We are not responsible for the accuracy of any information provided by third parties or third party policies or practices.

3. Use of Information.

We may use information about you, including your Personal Information, for any purposes consistent with our statements under this Privacy Policy or as permitted by applicable law, including to:

- Manage our Site and Software;

- Respond to your comments, questions, and requests, and provide customer service;
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts, information regarding changes to our policies, and support and administrative messages;
- Prevent and address fraud, breach of policies or terms, and threats or harm;
- Monitor and analyse trends, usage, and activities.
- Conduct research, including focus groups and surveys;
- Improve the Site or other EXINI websites, applications, marketing efforts, products and services;
- Send you information and news about other EXINI and affiliated company products, services and applications that may be of interest to you (for information about how to manage these communications, please see “Your Choices” below);
- Send you advertisements and communicate with you regarding our and our affiliated company products, services, offers, promotions, and events we think you may be interested in (for information about how to manage these communications and marketing efforts, please see “Your Choices” below); and
- Fulfill any other purpose disclosed at the time you provide Personal Information.

By providing your mobile number when you set up an account for the Software, you agree that EXINI may send you a security code via text message or call (including by automatic telephone dialing system) after you initially sign up for, and every time you attempt to log-in to, the Software, in order to confirm your request to set up an account and to verify your identity. Standard message, data, and other fees may be charged by your carrier.

4. Sharing of Information.

Our agents, vendors, consultants, and other service providers (collectively “**Service Providers**”) may receive, or be given access to your information, including Personal Information and Usage Information, in connection with their work on our behalf. These Service Providers are prohibited from using your Personal Information for any purpose other than to provide this assistance, although we may permit them to use aggregate information which does not identify you or de-identified data for other purposes.

In addition, we may share information about you with third parties for any purposes consistent with our statements under this Privacy Policy or as permitted by applicable law, including as follows:

- To comply with the law or other legal process;
- To protect the rights, property, life, health, security and safety of us, the Site or any third party;

- In connection with, or during negotiations of, any proposed or actual merger, purchase, sale or any other type of acquisition or business combination of all or any portion of our assets, or transfer of all or a portion of our business to another company;
- To monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities, including through CRM applications operated by third party companies, and send you information about our and our affiliates' products, services and applications based on such analysis;
- With our affiliates and parent company for internal business purposes;
- With our affiliates and parent company, business partners, and other third parties for their own business purposes, including direct marketing purposes (California residents have certain rights set forth in "Your California Privacy Rights" below);
- For purposes disclosed at the time you provide Personal Information; and
- With your consent or at your direction.

Without limiting the foregoing, in our sole discretion, we may share aggregated information which does not identify you or de-identified information about you with third parties or affiliates for any purpose.

5. Third Party Services and Analytics.

Our Site includes hyperlinks to websites, locations, platforms, or services operated by third parties ("**Third Party Service(s)**"). These Third Party Services may use Tracking Technologies to independently collect information about you and may solicit Personal Information from you.

We may use Google Analytics and other Service Providers for analytics services. These analytics services may use Tracking Technologies to help EXINI analyze Site users and how they use the Site. Information generated by these services (e.g., your IP address and other Usage Information) may be transmitted to and stored by these Service Providers on servers in the U.S. (or elsewhere) and these Service Providers may use this information for purposes such as evaluating your use of the Site, compiling statistic reports on the Site's activity, and providing other services relating to Site activity and other internet usage.

To the extent we combine information from Third Party Services with Personal Information we collect directly from you on the Site, we will treat the combined information as Personal Information under this Privacy Policy. Otherwise, the information collected and stored by third parties remains subject to their policies and practices, including whether they continue to share information with us, the types of information shared, and your choices on what is visible to others on Third Party Services. We are not responsible for and make no representations regarding the policies or business practices of any third parties or Third Party Services and encourage you to familiarize yourself with and consult their privacy policies and terms of use.

6. Your Choices.

A. Tracking Technologies Generally.

Regular cookies may generally be disabled or removed by tools available as part of most commercial browsers, and in some instances blocked in the future by selecting certain settings. Browsers offer different functionalities and options so you may need to set them separately. Please be aware that if you disable or remove these technologies some parts of the Site may not work and that when you revisit the Site your ability to limit browser-based Tracking Technologies is subject to your browser settings and limitations.

Your browser settings may allow you to automatically transmit a “Do Not Track” signal to online services you visit. Note, however, there is no industry consensus as to what site and app operators should do with regard to these signals. B. Analytics Tracking Technologies.

C. Communications.

You can opt-out of receiving certain promotional communications from us at any time following the instructions as provided in e-mails to click on the unsubscribe link or by sending an e-mail to us support@bonescanindex.com with the word UNSUBSCRIBE in the subject field of the e-mail. Please note that your opt-out is limited to the e-mail address or device used and will not affect subsequent subscriptions or non-promotional communications, such as those about your account, two-factor authentication, transactions, servicing, or EXINI’s ongoing business relations.

7. Your California Privacy Rights.

California’s “Shine the Light” law permits customers in California to request certain details about how certain types of their information are shared with third parties and, in some cases, affiliates, for those third parties’ and affiliates’ own direct marketing purposes. Under the law, a business should either provide California customers certain information upon request or permit California customers to opt in to, or opt out of, this type of sharing.

EXINI may share personal information as defined by California’s “Shine the Light” law with third parties and/or affiliates, including its parent company, for such third parties’ and affiliates’ own direct marketing purposes. 8. **Your European Privacy Rights.**

If you are a European data subject, you have the right to ask us not to disclose your Personal Information to third parties (other than to our service providers, agents, and affiliates) or use your Personal Information for purposes materially different than for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized by you. You also have the right to access certain Personal Information we have about you as required by applicable law in your home country and local regulations. We may require additional information from you to allow us to confirm your identity. Please note that we will retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

9. **Children.**

The Site is intended for a general audience and not directed to children less than thirteen (13) years of age. EXINI does not intend to collect personal information as defined by the U.S. Children’s Privacy Protection Act (“COPPA”) in a manner that is not permitted by COPPA. 10. **Data Security.**

We take reasonable measures to help protect information about you from loss, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. Nevertheless, transmission via the internet is not completely secure and we cannot guarantee the security of your information collected through our Site.

11. **EU Data Transfers and Privacy Shield.**

If you are accessing the Service or Software from outside of the United States, please be aware that information collected through the Service and Software may be transferred to, processed, stored, and used in the U.S. For example, under certain circumstances, we may transfer your Personal Information to our parent company, Progenics Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (“Progenics”), which is based in the United States. Progenics has applied to participate in the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding personal information collected from the European Union and European Economic Area. Progenics has certified to the Department of Commerce that it adheres to the Privacy Shield Principles of notice, choice, accountability for onward transfer, security, data integrity

Data protection laws in the U.S. may be different from those of your country of residence. Your use of the Service or Software, or provision of any information therefore constitutes your consent to the transfer to and from, processing, usage, sharing and storage of your information, including Personal Information, in the U.S. as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

12. Changes to this Privacy Policy.

We reserve the right to revise and reissue this Privacy Policy at any time. Any changes will be effective immediately upon posting of the revised Privacy Policy. Your continued use of our Site indicates your consent to the Privacy Policy then posted. If the changes are material, we may provide you additional notice, to your e-mail address.
